1. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. He do his work daily.
- B. He does his work daily.
- C. He doing his work daily.
- D. He did his work daily always.

Correct Answer: B. He does his work daily.

Explanation: With singular subject "he," we use "does" in the present simple tense. "Do" is used with I, we, you, and they. The sentence shows a daily habit, so present simple tense is correct.

2. Choose the correct form: She _____ to school every day.

- A. go
- B. goes
- C. going
- D. gone

Correct Answer: B. goes

Explanation: "She" is a third-person singular subject, so the verb takes "s/es" in the present simple tense. Therefore, "goes" is correct.

3. Identify the correct sentence:

- A. They was playing cricket.
- B. They were playing cricket.
- C. They is playing cricket.
- D. They be playing cricket.

Correct Answer: B. They were playing cricket.

Explanation: "They" is a plural subject, so it takes "were" in the past continuous tense. The structure is subject + was/were + verb-ing.

4. Choose the correct article: He is _____ honest man.

- A. a
- B. an
- C. the
- D. no article

Correct Answer: B. an

Explanation: "Honest" begins with a vowel sound because "h" is silent. We use "an" before vowel sounds, so "an honest man" is correct.



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5. Choose the correct article: She bought _____ umbrella.

- A. a
- B. an
- C. the
- D. no article

Correct Answer: B. an

Explanation: "Umbrella" begins with a vowel sound, so "an" is used before it. Articles depend on sound, not only spelling.

6. Choose the correct preposition: He is good _____ mathematics.

- A. in
- B. at
- C. on
- D. for

Correct Answer: B. at

Explanation: The correct phrase is "good at" a subject or skill. We say "good at mathematics," "good at English," and "good at solving problems."

7. Choose the correct preposition: She is interested _____ biology.

- A. on
- B. at
- C. in
- D. for

Correct Answer: C. in

Explanation: The correct expression is "interested in." We use "in" after interested when talking about a subject, activity, or field.

8. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. I have seen him yesterday.
- B. I saw him yesterday.
- C. I see him yesterday.
- D. I had saw him yesterday.

Correct Answer: B. I saw him yesterday.

Explanation: "Yesterday" is a completed past time, so simple past tense is used. "Saw" is the past form of "see." Present perfect is not normally used with finished past time expressions like yesterday.

9. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. She has completed her work.
- B. She have completed her work.
- C. She having completed her work.
- D. She completed has her work.

Correct Answer: A. She has completed her work.

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Explanation: With singular subject "she," we use "has." Present perfect tense structure is subject + has/have + past participle.

10. Choose the correct passive voice: He writes a letter.

- A. A letter is written by him.
- B. A letter was written by him.
- C. A letter has written by him.
- D. A letter wrote by him.

Correct Answer: A. A letter is written by him.

Explanation: The active sentence is in present simple tense. Passive voice structure for present simple is object + is/am/are + past participle + by + subject.

11. Choose the correct passive voice: She is cooking food.

- A. Food is cooked by her.
- B. Food was cooked by her.
- C. Food is being cooked by her.
- D. Food has cooked by her.

Correct Answer: C. Food is being cooked by her.

Explanation: The active sentence is in present continuous tense. Passive structure is object + is/am/are + being + past participle.

12. Choose the correct indirect speech: He said, "I am busy."

- A. He said that I am busy.
- B. He said that he was busy.
- C. He said that he is busy.
- D. He says that he was busy.

Correct Answer: B. He said that he was busy.

Explanation: In indirect speech, pronoun changes according to the speaker, and present tense changes into past tense when reporting verb is in the past. "I am" becomes "he was."

13. Choose the correct indirect speech: She said, "I have done my work."

- A. She said that she has done her work.
- B. She said that she had done her work.
- C. She said that I had done my work.
- D. She said that she did her work.

Correct Answer: B. She said that she had done her work.

Explanation: Present perfect tense changes into past perfect tense in indirect speech when reporting verb is past. "I" changes to "she," and "my" changes to "her."

14. Choose the correct degree: Ali is taller _____ Ahmed.

- A. then
- B. than
- C. from



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D. to

Correct Answer: B. than

Explanation: In comparative degree, "than" is used for comparison. "Then" refers to time, while "than" is used to compare two persons or things.

15. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. This is more better.
- B. This is better.
- C. This is best than that.
- D. This is much best.

Correct Answer: B. This is better.

Explanation: "Better" is already the comparative form of "good." We do not use "more" with better. "More better" is grammatically incorrect.

16. Choose the correct pronoun: Everyone should do _____ duty.

- A. their
- B. his
- C. its
- D. them

Correct Answer: B. his

Explanation: In traditional exam grammar, "everyone" is treated as singular, so "his" is commonly accepted. In modern usage, "their" is also often used, but for AFNS/AMC/NUMS exam grammar, "his" is usually expected.

17. Choose the correct verb: The news _____ true.

- A. are
- B. were
- C. is
- D. have

Correct Answer: C. is

Explanation: "News" looks plural but is singular in meaning. Therefore, it takes a singular verb: "The news is true."

18. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. Mathematics are difficult.
- B. Mathematics is difficult.
- C. Mathematics were difficult.
- D. Mathematics have difficult.

Correct Answer: B. Mathematics is difficult.

Explanation: Names of subjects ending in "s," such as mathematics, physics, and economics, are treated as singular when referring to a subject. So "is" is correct.



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19. Choose the correct conjunction: He is poor _____ honest.

- A. but
- B. and
- C. because
- D. or

Correct Answer: A. but

Explanation: "But" is used to show contrast. The sentence contrasts poverty with honesty, so "but" is the correct conjunction.

20. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. Neither Ali nor his friends was present.
- B. Neither Ali nor his friends were present.
- C. Neither Ali or his friends were present.
- D. Neither Ali and his friends were present.

Correct Answer: B. Neither Ali nor his friends were present.

Explanation: With "neither...nor," the verb agrees with the subject nearer to it. Here, the nearer subject is "friends," which is plural, so "were" is correct.

21. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. Either the teacher or the students is responsible.
- B. Either the teacher or the students are responsible.
- C. Either the teacher nor the students are responsible.
- D. Either the teacher and the students are responsible.

Correct Answer: B. Either the teacher or the students are responsible.

Explanation: With "either...or," the verb agrees with the subject closer to it. "Students" is plural and nearest to the verb, so "are" is correct.

22. Choose the correct form: If I _____ you, I would accept the offer.

- A. am
- B. was
- C. were
- D. be

Correct Answer: C. were

Explanation: In unreal or hypothetical conditions, "were" is used with all subjects. The correct structure is: If + subject + were, subject + would + base verb.

23. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. He is senior than me.
- B. He is senior to me.
- C. He is senior from me.
- D. He is senior of me.

Correct Answer: B. He is senior to me.





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Explanation: Some adjectives take "to" instead of "than," such as senior, junior, superior, inferior, prior, and preferable. Therefore, "senior to" is correct.

24. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. I prefer tea than coffee.
- B. I prefer tea to coffee.
- C. I prefer tea from coffee.
- D. I prefer tea with coffee.

Correct Answer: B. I prefer tea to coffee.

Explanation: The verb "prefer" is followed by "to," not "than." Therefore, the correct expression is "prefer tea to coffee."

25. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. He did not went to school.
- B. He did not go to school.
- C. He does not went to school.
- D. He did not gone to school.

Correct Answer: B. He did not go to school.

Explanation: After "did not," the base form of the verb is used. Therefore, "go" is correct, not "went" or "gone."

26. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. She does not likes mangoes.
- B. She does not like mangoes.
- C. She do not like mangoes.
- D. She did not likes mangoes.

Correct Answer: B. She does not like mangoes.

Explanation: After "does not," the main verb remains in base form. The "s/es" is already carried by "does," so we use "like," not "likes."

27. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. I am looking forward to meet you.
- B. I am looking forward to meeting you.
- C. I am looking forward meet you.
- D. I am looking forward for meeting you.

Correct Answer: B. I am looking forward to meeting you.

Explanation: In the phrase "look forward to," the word "to" is a preposition, not an infinitive marker. Therefore, it is followed by a gerund, meaning verb + ing.

28. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. He is suffering from fever.
- B. He is suffering with fever.
- C. He is suffering by fever.

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D. He is suffering at fever.

Correct Answer: A. He is suffering from fever.

Explanation: The correct preposition after "suffering" is "from." We say "suffering from fever," "suffering from pain," or "suffering from a disease."

29. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. The teacher gave me an advice.
- B. The teacher gave me advice.
- C. The teacher gave me advices.
- D. The teacher gave me many advices.

Correct Answer: B. The teacher gave me advice.

Explanation: "Advice" is an uncountable noun, so we do not use "an" or plural "advices" with it. Correct forms are "advice" or "a piece of advice."

30. Choose the correct sentence:

- A. He has been studying since two hours.
- B. He has been studying for two hours.
- C. He studied since two hours.
- D. He is studying since two hours.

Correct Answer: B. He has been studying for two hours.

Explanation: "For" is used with a period of time, such as two hours, three days, or five years.

"Since" is used with a starting point, such as Monday, 2020, or morning. The sentence shows an action continuing up to now, so present perfect continuous tense is correct.

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
