Correct Answer: B. for

Explanation: "For" is used with a period of time, such as two hours, three days, or many years. "Since" is used with a starting point of time, such as Monday or 2020.

Explanation: "Since" is used with a definite starting point in time. The year 2018 shows when the action started, so "since" is correct. The sentence is in present perfect continuous/simple sense.

Explanation: "On" is used when something is placed on the surface of another thing. Since the book is placed on the surface of the table, "on" is the correct preposition.

Explanation: We use "in" with cities, countries, and large areas. Lahore is a city, so the correct sentence is: He was born in Lahore.

Explanation: The word "now" shows that the action is happening at the present moment. Therefore, present continuous tense is used: is/am/are + verb-ing. With "she," we use "is doing."

Correct Answer: C. have known

Explanation: "Since Monday" shows an action or state that started in the past and continues up to the present. Therefore, present perfect tense is used. With "I," the correct form is "have known."

Correct Answer: C. had left

Explanation: When two past actions are mentioned, the earlier past action is expressed in past perfect tense. The train left before we arrived, so "had left" is correct.

Correct Answer: B. goes

Explanation: The phrase "every day" shows a regular or habitual action. Simple present tense is used, and with the third-person singular subject "she," the verb becomes "goes."

Explanation: The sentence shows an action that was continuing in the past when another action happened. Therefore, past continuous tense is used: was/were + verb-ing. With "they," we use "were having."

Explanation: The word "already" often indicates present perfect tense when the result is connected to the present. With the singular subject "he," we use "has completed."

Explanation: This is a first conditional sentence. The condition is in simple present tense "if it rains," and the result is in future simple tense "will stay."

Explanation: The action of studying started before another past action "you came" and continued for some time. Therefore, past perfect continuous tense is used: had been + verb-ing.

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
